**Attention Operators of Schools, Private Schools and Day Nurseries:**

As you know, in June of 2007, the Government passed a regulation under the *Safe Drinking Water Act, 2002* (Ontario Regulation 243/07) governing flushing and lead testing requirements for schools, private schools and day nurseries. Amendments of a technical nature were made to the regulation in late July. Ontario Regulation 243/07 requires weekly flushing for schools, private schools and day nurseries that are housed in a building where no part of the plumbing that serves the building was installed before January 1<sup>st</sup>, 1990. If, however, all or part of the plumbing in the building that houses the school, private school or day nursery was installed before January 1<sup>st</sup>, 1990, the regulation requires daily flushing.

The regulation also imposes requirements for annual lead sampling and testing on all schools and private schools, as well as on day nurseries that are served by plumbing installed before January 1<sup>st</sup>, 1990. Schools and private schools are required to take two samples of water and test them for lead between the period of June 15<sup>th</sup> and August 15<sup>th</sup>. Day nurseries are required to take two samples of water and test them for lead between the period of May 1 and October 31<sup>st</sup>. The Ministry is now receiving the results of the testing from schools and private schools.

***The Ministry is recommending that daily flushing commence at all schools and private schools and day nurseries that are housed in buildings where no part of the plumbing was installed before January 1, 1990.*** In response to a few test results showing exceedences in schools with plumbing installed post-1990, the Ministry is recommending this practice as a precautionary measure for the start of the school year. Over the next few months, the Ministry will analyze all the lead testing results it receives from schools, private schools and day nurseries more closely, to determine the number of lead exceedences that are being found in schools, private schools and day nurseries that are served by newer plumbing. A subsequent letter will be issued to schools, private schools and day nurseries to determine whether it is necessary to continue with this recommended practice of daily flushing for schools, private schools and day nurseries that are served by newer plumbing.

If you have any questions about the steps to flush plumbing outlined in Ontario Regulation 243/07 and the circumstances when you should consider taking additional measures to flush the plumbing in a building beyond those specified in the regulation, please contact your local Ministry of Environment Office.
