Donation of Food List

This list is required to determine if any potentially hazardous food has been donated to the event. This information is also important in the event of a food bourne illness outbreak (e.g. food poisoning). "Potentially hazardous food" refers to any food that is can support the growth of pathogenic organisms or the production of any toxins by these organisms. Examples include foods containing meat or poultry, dairy products, cooked rice, egg salad and potato salad.
