

High Rates of ATV injuries in Thunder Bay District

In the Thunder Bay Region, there are about **150** emergency department visits for ATV injuries each year. In 2015, **50%** of these were among 10-29 year-olds and emergency department visits for ATV injuries were **2.3** times higher for the Thunder Bay region compared to the rest of Ontario.

Please help reduce these injuries by:

- Always wearing an approved helmet and other safety gear
- Never carrying a passenger on a single rider ATV
- Getting trained before you ride
- Never riding under the influence of alcohol or other drugs
- Supervising riders younger than 16
