

Patron information will be collected

Premises that serve food and drink are required by law to collect the following information:



Contact information of patrons, as well as the date, times, and seating location of each visit.



This patron information shall be disclosed to the medical officer of health or a public health inspector, if required for COVID-19 contact tracing or other public health purposes.



Patron information will be stored securely for 30 days and then destroyed by the premise operator, if it is not used for the purposes outlined above.
