Diapering Procedure

Glove use is **NOT required** for diapering if you can diaper without direct hand contact with stool or urine. Glove use is not a substitute for hand washing—you must wash your hands and the child's hands after every diaper change. This procedure must be followed for each child in order to prevent the spread of communicable diseases.



1. Gather supplies



2. Clean your hands



3. Put on gloves (OPTIONAL)



4. Remove soiled diaper



5. Clean the child



6. Remove gloves (IF USED)



7. Clean your hands



8. Apply barrier product if needed, using tissue or glove



9. Put on clean diaper and wash both the child and worker's hands

Clean and disinfect the diaper change surface after each child, making sure that the entire surface remains wet for the contact time required by the product you are using. Follow the manufacturer's directions for use found on the product label.
