The project is led by the Thunder Bay District Health Unit and the Thunder Bay Drug Strategy (Drug Awareness Committee), in collaboration with education stakeholders and community-based organizations. It builds on the evidence and opportunities identified in the 2015 report:

"Trends and Promising Practices in School-Based Substance Misuse Prevention".

# Framework

This project takes as its framework the Public Health Agency of Canada's: Blueprint for Action: Preventing Substance-related Harms Among Youth Through A Comprehensive School Health Approach.<sup>2</sup> Comprehensive School Health is a recognized approach to building healthy schools that is widely used in Canada. The Blueprint for Action marries this framework to four, evidence-based approaches to preventing substance-related harms.
