Important School Immunization Information for Grade 7 Students

2023/2024 School Year

Dear Parent or Legal Guardian:

As part of Ontario's Grade 7 Immunization Program, the Thunder Bay District Health Unit offers the following immunizations at your child's school:

Meningococcal-C-ACYW-135 Vaccine	1 dose * required for school attendance
Human Papillomavirus-9 Vaccine	2 doses given 6 months apart
Hepatitis B Vaccine	2 doses given 6 months apart

With parental consent, the Health Unit's immunization team is planning to provide **two** in-school immunization clinics at your child's school.

What you need to do:

Complete and sign the attached consent form.



Return the form to your child's school office by Tuesday, September 19.

PLEASE NOTE:

- 1. If you decide to have your child immunized by your Health Care Provider, please submit the information to the Thunder Bay District Health Unit immediately following the immunization.
- 2. Parental consent for vaccines offered in Grade 7 remain active for the duration of your child's Grade 7 and 8 school years, so that missed vaccines in Grade 7 can be offered at school clinics when your child is in Grade 8.
