WHAT IS LEVAMISOLE?

Levamisole is an anti-parasitic drug used to treat parasites in animals. Also known as a de-wormer. It is available as a white powder form similar to cocaine. Levamisole is often found as a cutting agent in substances like cocaine, amphetamines and fentanyl. This is due to it being cheap to purchase and dissolves easily into substances. It will reduce the quality of drugs.

There is no benefit of this veterinary drug for humans. Levamisole can cause joint stiffness, tissue death, infections, swollen glands, painful sores and weakening your immune system by decreasing your white blood cell count.

Can I overdose on Levamisole?

NOT EXACTLY! You cannot overdose on Levamisole, but it important to remember you can overdose on what it is cut into!

- ✓ Do not use alone
- ✓ Download the Lifeguard app
- ✓ Start with a test shot/line
- ✓ Carry Nalaxone
