1. PURPOSE

- 1.1. This procedure provides governing principles for fostering a psychologically healthy and safe workplace.
- 1.2. This procedure supports Policy No. BH-02-18 Psychological Health and Safety.

2. PROCEDURE

- 2.1. Administration will foster an organizational culture that values psychological health and safety by:
 - Promoting a respectful, stigma-free workplace and enhancing mental health awareness.
 - Implementing prevention strategies addressing workplace psychological risks through primary, secondary, and tertiary interventions.
 - Monitoring and evaluating psychological health and safety initiatives to support continuous improvement.
- 2.2. Administration will ensure that organizational policies, programs, and practices integrate psychological health and safety considerations at all levels.

3. SCOPE

3.1. This procedure applies to all employees within TBDHU.

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4. RESPONSIBILITY

4.1. Senior Leadership is responsible for ensuring that psychological health and safety is reflected in the strategic direction and goals of TBDHU.

- 4.2. Management is responsible for modelling, promoting, and championing the ideals of a healthy workplace, and supporting psychological health and safety standards and initiatives in their programs.
- 4.3. Human Resources is responsible for ensuring all new employees are made aware of the Psychological Health and Safety Committee and related organizational initiatives during orientation.
- 4.4. Employees are responsible for fostering and maintaining a psychologically healthy and safe work environment.
- 4.5. Psychological Health and Safety Committee is responsible for meeting the requirements set out in Canada's National Standards for Psychological Health and Safety in the Workplace by planning and implementing organizational initiatives.
